2018 October Item 3) The Community Council Elections had a record turn out of 73 voters despite considerable criticism of how the advertising had been managed by SLC. This discussion had been covered in detail at the AGM which preceded this meeting.

2018 October Item 6) Halloween and Fireworks Night events had both been very successful community events with good attendance.

2018 November Item 3) Adopt a Planter Scheme

This had been suggested at the WAT IF?/TCC meeting in October and was considered to be a good idea by everyone present. It was also approved at October TCC meeting but needed to await new council to: 1) approve and 2) agree details such as: need for a sub-group and if so who? The group voted unanimously to proceed with the scheme.

Terms of reference would now need to be drafted, approved and agreed before we can proceed further. Patricia and Alistair agreed to form a small sub-group to look at this, discuss with WAT IF? and bring back to the TCC

2018 November Item 6) Tarbrax Village Hall Feedback from Patricia

- c. The Children's Christmas Party has been arranged for Friday 14th December
- d. The Tarbrax & District Christmas Dinner has been arranged for Monday 3rd December 6pm tickets £5.00
- e. The TVHA will not be running a Hogmanay event this year.
- f. A meeting has been held recently between the TVHA and the Tarbrax Common Association to discuss how the new charity (TCVHT) and the TCA can work together going forward.
- g. Councillor Julia Marrs has sadly resigned as the SLC Representative to Tarbrax Village Hall due to pressure of work from other Committees. Tarbrax Village Hall Committee are waiting to hear who the new Councillor representative will be.

Email from resident regarding problems with recycling. The change of policy on receiving waste from small domestic trailers is causing considerable problems for people in rural areas. Both in disposing of their own larger waste items and in having an increasing amount of other people's waste illegally dumped in our fields, gateways and roadsides.

Discussion followed. The Councillors agreed to look into this for us.
